WAYNE COUNTY FAIR ROYALTY PAGEANT CRITERIA

- Contestants must be single and never married. Contestants must be currently attending a public/parochial school or being home schooled and a resident of Wayne County or a member of a Wayne County 4-H Club. Winners should plan to attend Opening Ceremonies and the Wayne County Fair Parade during the Wayne County Fair. Opportunity for additional public appearances will be given through to November 7, 2023.
- Contestants must be able to listen and take direction from Pageant Committee members. Failure to do so will result in being asked to not compete or if selected, asked to relinquish your title.
- No Royalty Pageant candidate or elected members of the Royalty Court shall consume any alcohol or drugs, smoke or swear during any pre-pageant activity or Fair event, or otherwise conduct themselves not in the keeping with the standing of that of a member of the Fair Royalty Court.
- Any Royalty Pageant candidate, or elected members of the Royalty Court who shall be arrested, or whose activities shall give an appearance of impropriety, during the pre-pageant activities, or after their election, shall be subject to review by the Royalty Pageant Directors, and if the candidate or Royalty Pageant activities shall be found not to be consistent with the high standards expected of a member of the Royalty Court, then the Royalty Court member will be expected to tender their resignation and to withdraw from the competition, or to surrender their title and allow their successor to succeed them regardless of the date of such action or determination.
- Social media encompasses a broad sweep of online activity. Please remember these communication avenues are trackable and traceable, once sent it never goes away and it lives forever. If you would not say it to their face, do not put it on a social network platform. These networks include not only the blogs that a contestant or member of the 2023 Royalty Court may author and/or may contribute, but also social media web sites such as Facebook©, Instagram™, Snapchat©, TikTok™, Twitter©, YouTube©; professional networks such as LinkedIn®, the liveblogging tool; and social bookmarking such as Digg and Delicious. Each contestant and member of the 2023 Royalty Court must speak respectfully about the Wayne County Fair, the 2023 Contestants and 2023 Wayne County Fair Royalty and/or any prior royalty, our current and/or potential employees, guests, partners, and competitors. Contestants/Royalty are not permitted to engage in name-calling or behavior that will negatively reflect themselves, others in the contest or the Fair's reputation. Please note that the use of copyrighted materials, unfounded or derogatory statements, or any misrepresentation that is not viewed favorably by Wayne County Fair Board can result in disciplinary action for the sender up to and including that person, or group, could be asked to not compete or if selected to be a member of the Royalty Court, then you could be asked to relinquish any prizes and position.
- Any contestant currently reigning as a member of another organization that would conflict with being able to fulfill
 responsibilities if chosen as a member of the Wayne County Fair Royalty, is NOT eligible to compete until their reign
 is over.
- The decisions of the Royalty Pageant Directors concerning discipline, or otherwise regarding the running of the pageant, etc., are final and they shall be the sole arbitrators of all such matters.
- The Royalty Court are chosen on poise, personality, public speaking, interview, and formal attire competition. All contestants must prepare and present a one-minute speech on <u>one</u> of the following topics: Union Agricultural Society @ Palmyra aka Wayne County Fair or something about your town or Wayne County.
- There is no entry fee! Fundraising is done at the Wayne County Fair selling candy, water and 50/50 tickets at grandstand events.
- Any discrepancies/problems should be reported to the Wayne County Fair Royalty Directors IMMEDIATELY!
- Parent/guardian will be responsible for their child's actions if selected to the Royalty Court at all appearances. Members of the Royalty Court will be asked to attend scheduled public appearances (it is not mandatory to be available for all events except Opening Ceremonies, 1 pm on Monday of the Fair and the Wayne County Fair Parade on Friday, 7 pm during Fair week). Royalty will be given an opportunity to sign up for other activities during the week of the Fair.
- A list of Fair rules will be handed out to winners selected to the Royalty Court.
- Parent/guardian of the Royalty Court may be asked to assist the Pageant Committee with supporting public appearances.
- Parent/guardian of the Royalty Court will be required to assist the Pageant Committee for at least <u>one</u> grandstand event during the week of the Wayne County Fair (evenings).
