The Palmyra Harvest on the Canal is holding a poster competition open to all artists and all mediums to create a unique piece depicting the Palmyra Harvest on the Canal and 200 year celebration of the Erie Canal.

All ages are welcome to participate.

Winner's artwork may appear on posters, note cards, and other promotional materials.

Winning artist will be notified by the end of July. Winning Artwork will be revealed at the Wayne County Fair.

2025 is the year of the Erie Canal Bicentennial. Artists are encouraged to incorporate the Bicentennial graphics into their design. Graphics and guidelines can be found at

Winner's artwork will be revealed at the Wayne County Fair (August 4-10) on a day to be determined. Artist needs to be present.

- The Union Agricultural Society at Palmyra (UASP) receives exclusive rights to the winning work for the duration of the year of 2025-2026 to be used in the promotion of Palmyra Harvest on the Canal (PHOC). Any media or product created during such time (posters, cards, t-shirts, etc.) will remain the property of UASP and may continue to be used and sold by UASP and its merchants. This artwork may also be used to promote future PHOC Festivals. Artist does retain copyright within these guidelines.
- UASP and Palmyra Harvest on the Canal, its members, affiliates, and business invitees are not responsible for the return of or any lost, damaged, or stolen artwork.
- Arrangement for the return of artwork is the full responsibility of the artist and MUST be completed by August 30. After September 1st any artwork not picked up becomes the sole property of the UASP and Palmyra Harvest on the Canal.
- The exhibitor and/or family shall at all times protect, indemnify, save and keep harmless UASP, Palmyra Harvest on the Canal, its members, affiliates and business invitees from any damage, liability, or expense arising from or out of any loss or injury to any property or person, including the artist, its agents, employees and business invitees, which arise from or out of or by reason of the artist's participation in this event.
- No Entry fee.
- One (1) entry form per piece of art.
- Original artwork in all mediums will be accepted. If art is of a 3D nature, please submit a full resolution jpeg image (we reserve the right to have the piece re-photographed if needed)
- Artwork must represent our Palmyra Harvest on the Canal and should portray the spirit of this event.
- Submissions should be no larger than 16x20 and may be vertical or horizontal. UASP reserves the right to modify the winning design in accordance with the printing process.
- The only text to be placed on the work (other than artist's signature) is "Palmyra Harvest on the Canal 2025" (not required)
- Winning artist must be available for publicity interviews and pictures; these remain the property of the UASP.
- UASP reserves the right to disqualify entries, without notice, for failure to comply with the terms and conditions.
- Winning artist will be notified by the end of July.
