1. All entries must be submitted prior to show starting time.
2. Entries can be mailed in prior to event. Mailing information on Class Entry Form (Strongly Suggested).
3. Show attire is not required.
4. The Show is for Draft Type Horses or Draft Ponies. (No Light Harness Horses)
5. Horses and Ponies will NOT be faulted for shoeing, type of shoeing or lack thereof.
6. Riding In Harness - **All riders under 18 must wear helmet, NYS Law as of 2013.**
7. Proof of current Negative Coggins & Rabies Vaccination (Certificate) copies to be provided at registration.
8. All Youth are Required to wear an ASTM Approved Helmet in all Classes per the NYS Law as of 2013.
9. If entries warrant, ponies will be judged separately.

**This show is for draft type horses and ponies. No light harness horses.
Horses and ponies will not be faulted for shoeing, type of shoeing or lack thereof.**

Halter Classes - to be judged on conformation, showmanship, and movement at judge's discretion.

Cart Classes - will be judged both directions of the ring with cart, buggy or light wagon. Open to both farm and hitch type horses, suitability to their respective vehicles to be judged.

Youth Showmanship - for exhibitors age 18 and under; in hand class. Will be judged on showmanship and fitting of the horse.

Youth Cart Class - exhibitors age 18 and under; All youth drivers must be accompanied by an adult on the cart. Will be judged in both directions of the ring. Cart, buggy or light wagon and suitability to their respective vehicles to be judged. Open to both farm and hitch type horses.

Youth Team – exhibitors age 18 and under; All youth drivers must be accompanied by an adult on the cart. Will be judged in both directions of the ring. Cart, buggy or light wagon and suitability to their respective vehicles to be judged. Open to both farm and hitch type horses. Pair will be driven.

Farm Hitch Class - to be judged on suitability to farm work. Disposition and precision to count.

Team Obstacle - course to be posted before the class. This is a timed event, penalty points will also be added for missed or touched obstacles. Fastest time with fewest penalty points wins.

Feed Team Race - course to be posted before the class. Two teams will compete at a time against the clock. The driver is not allowed to leave the sled at any time. Sled is not to move forward until the helper is on and is not to move when bales are being loaded or unloaded. Broken bales will be penalized.*basic course, time and space permitting, pass through timers, load 6 bales, unload 2 bales at each of three stops, go around marker, reload bales, unload all 6 at last stop, pass through timers*

Barrel race – timed event using a team and work sled – cloverleaf pattern.

Log Skid – timed event, pattern will be posted before the class.
