RULES:

1. 2026 Show is on the Main Floor of Floral Hall.
2. Judging to be held at 7:00 PM, Monday, August 10th, 2026.
3. Any entries the exhibitor wants returned after the Fair must be indicated by “Hold” on the entry tag.
4. All entries and ribbons will be released Sunday, August 16th, 2026 at 6pm.
Otherwise they become the property of Wayne County Fair. Superintendent must sign release for prize money.
5. Unauthorized removal of display will forfeit all prize money.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be in place by 6:30 PM, Monday, August 10th, 2026.

ENTRY FEES: Entry Fees: 10% of first-place premium. Payment must accompany entry.

PREMIUM AWARDS: Premiums will be available Wednesday afternoon in the Secretary’s Office. Awards are also available Sunday, August 16th, 2026 from 10 AM and 2PM.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All entries must be grown by exhibitor.
2. 1 exhibit per class per exhibitor.
3. Exhibits will be judged on uniformity, freedom from blemishes, and overall quality. Prizes will not be awarded to exhibits which are unworthy.
4. All exhibits entered in this department shall become the property of the Palmyra Union Agricultural Society unless prior arrangements are made with the department superintendent. **“HOLD”** shall be written on all entry tags where the exhibitor wishes to reclaim exhibit after the fair is completed.
5. All items may be made from cow, sheep, or goat. Alternate milk styles also accepted (almond, hemp, etc.) Items must be labeled with date of process, origin (Jersey cow, almond), and ingredients - **MUST BE WRITTEN ON A 3X5 INDEX CARD.**
6. Eggs must include label with breed of hens and dates of laying. All items will be judged based on quality and uniformity, shape, etc.
7. Processed items do NOT have to come from your own milking stock (you can purchase milk elsewhere and process it to cheese, yogurt, etc.) Items will be displayed in cooler.
8. Processed items **MUST** include a 3 x 5 index card with recipe and/or process.

Class:

1. Butter- salted or unsalted. Must provide between 4-8 tablespoons, packaged in jar or cubed and wrapped
2. Specialty butter- including ghee, blends, and other flavored butters. Packaged same as class 1
3. Milk- white milk. Provide 1/2 pint or equivalent sampling
4. Milk- skim milk. Provide 1/2 pint or equivalent sampling
5. Milk- flavored. Provide 1/2 pint or equivalent sampling (chocolate, coffee, other flavor)
6. Cheese- Mild Cheddar. Provide 4-8 ounces, wrapped
7. Cheese- Sharp Cheddar. Provide 4-8 ounces, wrapped
8. Cheese- Jack or Jack Variety. Provide 4-8 ounces, wrapped
9. Cheese- Other variety. Provide 4-8 ounces, wrapped
10. Cheese- Ricotta. Provide 4-8 ounces, wrapped or packaged in jar
11. Cottage Cheese- Provide 4-8 ounces, packaged in jar or tub
12. Cream Cheese- Provide 4-8 ounces, wrapped or packaged in jar or tub
13. Semi-Hard Cheese- (Gouda, Provolone, Swiss, etc.) Provide 4-8 ounces, wrapped
14. Semi-Soft Cheese- (Brie, Mozzarella, Havarti, etc.) Provide 4-8 ounces, wrapped (string ok)
15. Crumbled Cheese- (Cotija, Feta, Bleu, etc.) Provide 2-4 ounces, wrapped or packaged in jar or tub
16. Hard Cheese- (Parmesan, etc.) Provide 2-4 ounces, wrapped or packaged in jar or tub
17. Cheese Curds- Provide 2-4 ounces, wrapped or packaged in jar or tub
18. Yogurt- Natural/Unsweetened- Provide 2-4 ounces either in jar or tub
19. Yogurt- Flavored- Provide 2-4 ounces either in jar or tub
20. Yogurt- Greek- Provide 2-4 ounces either in jar or tub
21. Kefir- Provide 4-8 ounces in jar or bottle
22. Buttermilk- Provide 1/2 pint or equivalent sampling
23. Cream- Provide 1/2 pint or equivalent sampling
24. Sour Cream- Provide 2-4 ounces either in jar or tub
25. Any other dairy product- value added (coffee cream, frosting, cheesecake, etc.)

4. One dozen mixed eggs of any color or species (must all be same specie)-
displayed in open or clear carton
5. One half dozen eggs of any other bird species (quail, duck, etc.)-
displayed in open or clear carton
6. Creative egg display
