1. PLEASE NOTE **USE REGULAR ENTRY FORM FOR BEEF CATTLE.**
2. **Entries due/postmarked by (no exceptions) Friday, July 17, 2026 . (Please Review NEW Rule 7 in “Official Exhibitor Rules)**
3. **Arrival Information: All Livestock Entries enter to unload from the East Gate on Birdsall Parkway.**
4. All animals must be in place by 6:00 PM, Sunday, August 9th, 2026.
5. Entry fees: 10% of first place. (If \$30.00 first place then entry fee is \$3.00).
6. Market Class animals will be weighed at 10:00 AM Monday, August 10th
7. Judging begins at 12:00 PM Tuesday, August 11th, 2026, with showmanship. Open show to follow.
8. Bulls over 1 year of age may be brought in on day of show but must be shown off your trailer.
9. Animals must be removed after 8:00 PM, Tuesday, August 11th, 2026, to begin clean-up for the Dairy Show.
10. Animals must meet all Health Requirements as set forth by the NYS Department of Agriculture & Markets.
11. RABIES vaccinations MUST be given 14 days before the start of the fair.

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** Postmarked by **Friday, July 17, 2026** (After Said date “Added: Entry Fee will Apply)

### GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The names and number of cattle entered in Sections 7-10 inclusive must be given on the entry blank. Breeders may exhibit as many animals as they wish in each class, but no family or farm exhibitor will be allowed more than two (2) awards in any one class, unless ownership of these animals is under the name of separate family members.
2. No animal shall be entered in more than one (1) class, except that animals shown singly will be eligible for entry in the group classes. All animals shown in groups must be shown in appropriate age classes. **\*\* (i.e.: a breed class or market class, one animal cannot be entered in both)\*\***
3. Registration and health papers are to be presented to the superintendent for inspection before unloading at the fairgrounds.
4. These will be returned by the superintendent at the time of the health inspection.
5. ALL BULLS OVER SIX (6) MONTHS MUST BE LED WITH NOSE RING AND HALTER.
6. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE TIED WITH HALTERS AND NECK TIES.

7. ANIMALS MUST EXIT DOORS IN CATTLE PORTION OF BARN ONLY.
8. BANNERS - 1 EACH FOR GRAND AND RESERVE CHAMPION FEMALE BEEF, GRAND AND RESERVE CHAMPION BULL AND GRAND AND RESERVE MARKET ANIMAL - ARE ALL DONATED.
9. IF YOU PULL YOUR ANIMALS OUT PRIOR TO THE RELEASE TIME OF 8 PM ON TUESDAY, THEN YOU WILL FORFEIT YOUR PREMIUMS, UNLESS APPROVED BY LIVESTOCK SUPERINTENDENT.
10. Youth under the age of 18 that are staying on the fairgrounds overnight MUST adhere to the "BARN RULES" – Rules are printed in this Fair Book. An adult chaperon is a requirement.
11. The Wayne County Fair assumes no responsibility in case of loss, damage or accident to livestock, person or property from any cause while at the fairground. Entries are received upon this condition.
12. Any trailer staying overnight will be parked on the SOUTH WEST CORNER of the fairgrounds in the trailer parking area. Any trailer left overnight North of the horse show ring will be moved by fair personal.

#### REMINDER

13. Youth under the age of 18 that are staying on the fairgrounds overnight MUST adhere to the "BARN RULES" – Rules are printed in this Fair Book. An adult chaperon is a requirement.
14. Animals must exit doors in cattle portion of barn only.
15. **Any trailer staying overnight will be parked on the SOUTH WEST CORNER of the fairgrounds in the trailer parking area. Any trailer left over night North of the horse show ring will be moved by fair personal.**
