## SECTION 4 – DAHLIAS - Show Friday, August 14th, 2026

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** All entries for this show **must be in place between 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM** and be staged and ready for judging by 12 noon on Friday, August 14th, 2026.

**PREMIUM AWARDS:** Premiums for this show will be available in the Secretary's office Sunday Morning.

**ENTRY FEES:** Per entry 10% of 1st Place Premium of class entered into. (\$.50)

**PREMIUM AWARDS:** 1st place \$5.00, 2nd place \$3.00, 3rd place \$1.00, H.M. Ribbon.

### Rules:

1. There is an entry fee of 10% of the first place premium.
2. Entry tags will be furnished free of charge.
3. All specimens must have sufficient foliage attached to stem above top of container to permit its proper evaluation. Two sets of leaves will be about right for most sizes, however, one set will be acceptable on some small and miscellaneous types.
4. Each specimen must be disbudded and dis-branched.
5. Entries calling for three blooms must be 3 specimens of the same variety exhibited in one container.
6. An exhibitor may make multiple entries in a class if they are different varieties.
7. Please be sure of the following:
  1. Clips – used on stem of specimen
  2. Claim Check – remove from entry tag
  3. Strings – removed from entry tag
  4. Enough water – in bottle
  5. Wedges – ask Superintendent
  6. Make sure clerking sheet is returned immediately to Superintendent when completed
  7. Numbers designate size and form. Classes are not divided by color.
  8. Large classes may be subdivided if needed.
  9. **Classes 101, 102, 103 are open to Wayne County Residents only.**

#### **Rules:**

1. Fairy Garden Containers must fit in a 2 by 2 square footprint. The garden can be ANY height.
2. The Fairy Garden entry must be a living miniature garden. (No Artificial Plants Allowed.)
3. The Fairy Garden must be in good taste and pest free. The Wayne County Fair reserves all rights to reject any entry that is inappropriate.
4. Each Fairy Garden should include a short paragraph describing their garden.
5. Fairy Garden components (plants & accessories) can be obtained from any source.
6. Entrants are responsible for carrying in and setting up (if needed) their own Fairy Garden.
7. Entries will be displayed at the Wayne County Fair throughout the week. Entrants can pick up their displays on Sunday after 6pm. Any entries pick up prior to set pick up time MUST make arrangement with Show Supervisor prior to picking up arrangement.
8. Winners will be posted on **Wednesday, August 12th, 2026 by 5 pm.**
